

LEGAL NOTICE OF UPCOMING COURT HEARING SEEKING APPROVAL OF:  
**NISSAN CVT SETTLEMENT IN CANADA, EXCLUDING QUEBEC**

IF YOU OWN, OWNED, LEASE OR LEASED ONE OF THESE VEHICLES,  
THE SETTLEMENT MAY AFFECT YOUR LEGAL RIGHTS

If your vehicle suffers a failure of its Continuously Variable Transmission (“CVT”) within 7 years or 140,000 kilometres, whichever comes first, you may take your vehicle to an authorized dealership for repair and/or replacement under warranty.

If your vehicle previously suffered a failure of its CVT within 7 years or 140,000 kilometres, whichever comes first, **YOU MAY HAVE A CLAIM** for reimbursement of expenses you incurred to repair and/or replace the transmission assembly (including valve body and torque converter) or Automatic Transmission Control Unit (“ATCU”). If a Nissan dealer diagnosed and recommended a repair to the transmission assembly or ATCU of your vehicle, but you did not pay for the repair or replacement costs within that time period, **YOU MAY HAVE A CLAIM** for reimbursement if you pay for the recommended transmission repair prior to the Class Vehicle exceeding 155,000 kilometres or within ninety (90) days of the Approval Notice Date, whichever comes first.

If you used to own a vehicle that had two or more CVT component replacements or repairs to the transmission assembly, torque converter, valve body or ATCU, you may be eligible for a voucher of \$1,300 for the purchase or lease of a single Nissan or Infiniti vehicle per Class Vehicle.

The Settlement must be approved by the Ontario Superior Court of Justice to become effective. The hearing to consider whether to approve the Settlement will take place:

- **March 31, 2022:** Ontario Superior Court of Justice, location to be determined

The Court will approve amounts for legal fees and expenses to class counsel. Those amounts will be paid separately and will not reduce the Settlement benefits.

**YOU HAVE OPTIONS:**

- **Participate** in the Settlement, if approved by the Court, and make a claim for eligible benefits
- **Object** to the Settlement and attend the approval hearing if you wish
- **Exclude** yourself from the Settlement (opt out), in which case you will not be eligible to receive any benefits. You must take steps to exclude yourself from the Settlement if you do not wish to participate

To opt out or object, submit a request so it is received by March 4, 2022
